## Review

The wild country 'Back o'Skidda' saw round 4 of the Spring Series set off in perfect conditions but finish in rapidly deteriorating weather. This proved exceedingly testing for some of the later finishers, but did not trouble the two course winners.

Mike Robinson of Dark Peak made it 4 from 4 on the short course, but was chased all the way by 13 year old Daniel Spencer who was in hot pursuit at the top of Jenkin Hill. Mike finally put paid to Daniel's challenge on the descent, but this was an exceptional performance from the young West Cumberland Orienteer. Route choice proved crucial as the first four runners all chose to go up and over Lonscale Fell to the first check point on the Burnt Horse ridge; whilst others chose to go around Lonscale Fell. The latter route was longer, but had less climb. However the former emerged clearly the faster as Daniel finished over 10 minutes ahead of his friend and keen rival Alastair Thomas, who was fifth.

The long course saw the third winner from four starts as WCOC's Phil Winskill trotted up over 4 minutes ahead of CFR's Bill Williamson. Mike Harrison of WCOC was a close third 27 seconds behind Bill. WCOC's Angela Jackson was first woman home finishing 7 minutes ahead of second placed Anne Cummings.

The final event of the series starts at 6.15 on Thursday April 17<sup>th</sup> from Lanthwaite Green.
