I pattered contentedly down the reentrant behind Whin Ben, past the site of the '86 Beer Trail cache and along the roadside to the car. It was 3.45 and I was as high as a kite. Did my feet really touch the ground? I can hardly remember. Monday morning

shrugged my shoulders and grunted something non-commital, secretly thinking that anyone needing to ask the question would never understand the answer anyway.
