The rules are the same as always: at the first control you will (hopefully!) find a marker giving you the grid reference and description of the next. This year there are a total of 6 controls including the beer cache. Total straight line distance is about 15k although you could avoid some climbing by going a bit further.

You will need the 1:25,000 OS map of Caldbeck (NY 23/33) or the Harveys map of the area Back o'Skidda. Park on the roadside near the ford at GR 350350. The first control is at The Gully Bend GR329358.

There may be a notebook at the final control which is about 500m from your car. If so please leave any comments and the time you took. If it should be necessary, full details of the route can be obtained from me on 0900 823668, or if unavailable there, on 0642 54915.
