SPORTident have loaned us a small number of SIAir ecards for use at our spring series events. They allow proximity punching at the control, within 50cms! If you want to try one out you will need to get to the event early as there are only a limited number of ecards for use. CLEAR the card as usual, and then use the CHECK/SIAC on station to turn the ecard on. The finish control turns the ecard off. They are great for urban and sprint 'O'.
