### Maprun App.

We had a go with this App at a Sprint event at Keswick last autumn. You use your smart phone to register your progress around a course similar to a SIAC ecard. So... you download the App Maprun onto your phone (mine's an android), register your details. You select an event from Event List, in the UK folder, and then West Cumberland folder. It downloads a KMZ file for the course. Goto Start with your paper map (+course drawn on). The phone registers at each control around the course (although no actual controls needed!). Then Finish, and check your time in Results. We'll try it at Moorclose!
