## Parish Relays.

This year the Parish Relays will be held on Mawbray Dunes on 11th July. For those who are new to the event, and not familiar with the format etc. .... a brief explanation. Six short legs (loops) are planned, long, short and medium (2 of each) of approximately 3, 2 and 1km in length. Each team has three runners, with two runners out at any one time. Each team completes the 12km total in about 30-45 minutes. Once the six loops are completed there is a final different loop (of about 1km) for any one of the team members to complete. This format gives great head to head racing, with team members changing over fairly regularly. Since any leg/loop can be run in any order no one really knows which team is in the lead at any one time! If teams are close together the final loop becomes a real chase!

Teams are made up, if possible, from club members who live fairly close together, which often gives better balanced teams. Please start selecting your teams, and register them in the coming weeks. Juniors have their own competition relay.
