enteering in the area.



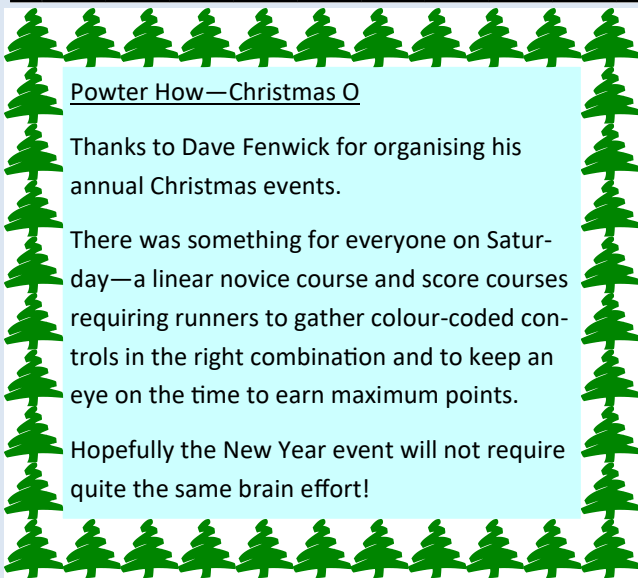

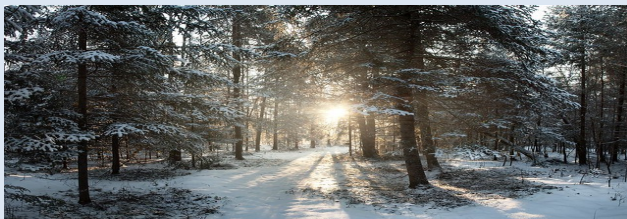


Powter How—Christmas O
