

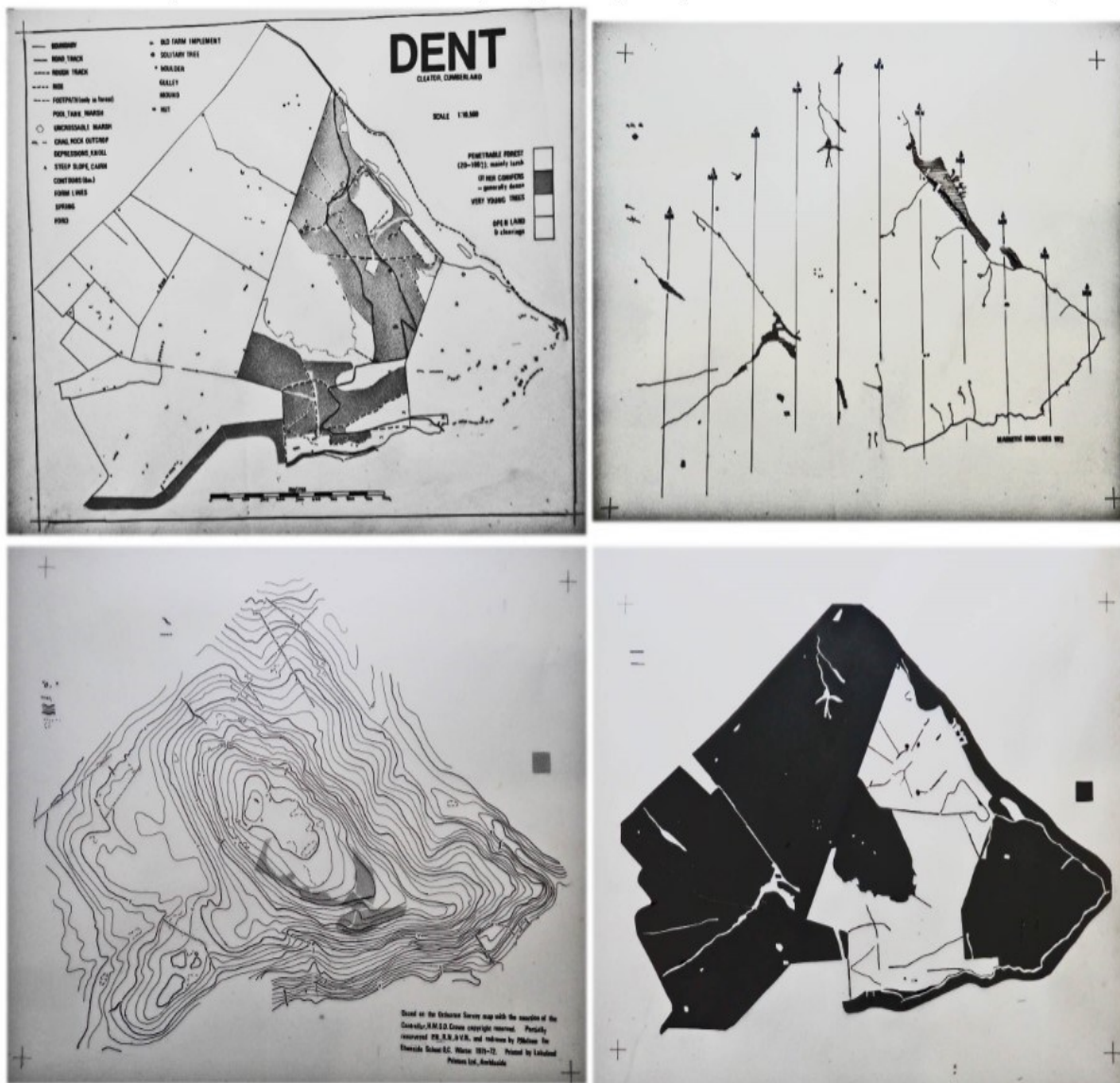
Events

BCE (Before Computers Existed) most orienteering maps were drawn in ink on plastic film. All the drawing was in black, and you needed one sheet for each colour. More colours cost more money, so early maps used shades of grey or brown for dense trees. Green came later, and it was a long time before we had other colours, like red. That's why you'll still see the club badge with a brown flash in the middle, not red. Here are the black, blue, brown, and yellow sheets for the 1972 Dent map.
