### Ennerdale Horseshoe Fell Race (Steve Breeze)



It must be significant because the Ennerdale Horseshoe Fell Race has its own Wikipedia page.

'The race was started in 1968 by Joe Long and Frank Travis of the West Cumberland Orienteering Club and in 1970 was taken on by the newly formed Cumberland Fell Runners Association, whose committee included both Long and Travis. The first nine editions of the race were all won by [Joss Naylor](#) who has noted that it was one of his 'favourite courses.'

The race is approximately 23 miles long with over 2000m of climb. There is some appeal to orienteers as there are more route choices than most fell races.

The opportunity to enter something must have got WCOC members past and present excited as there have been quite a few from the club. A quick scan of the entries reveals at least 8, including former WCOC junior and previous female winner of the race - Rosie Watson. The entry list also reveals entries from orienteers far and wide.

Entries opened on Monday to members of Fell Runners Association and were quickly closed again with 70% of the places taken (281). Entries open again on Monday 22nd (Today) to all comers.
